 Construction Fees and Escrow Fees must be paid via separate checks/money orders made payable to the Borough of Lawnside.
- All applications are to be submitted to the Borough of Lawnside Construction Department for forwarding to the Borough Engineer for review.
- Applications can be submitted via US Mail, hand delivery during business hours or dropped in red locked mailbox outside of the municipal building.
- Applications are processed within 10 business days of receipt.
- A letter of approval or denial will be sent via e-mail to the contact person identified on the application.
- Construction cannot begin until the applicant has received an approval from the Borough Engineer and the Borough Engineer has been notified of intended start date.







7. CONDITIONS

- a. All sidewalks and curbs constructed, reconstructed or repaired shall be in compliance with the current development regulations of the Borough of Lawnside.
- b. All work performed shall be done in a good and workman like manner to the standards prescribed herein and to the reasonable satisfaction of the Borough Engineer.
- c. All damage to adjoining areas resulting from this construction shall be the responsibility of the owner and shall be repaired to the satisfaction of the Borough Engineer.
- d. No pavement should be disturbed as part of this construction.
- e. Only whole sections of curb shall be removed and replaced.
- f. It shall be the responsibility of the owner or his contractor to notify the Borough Engineer at least twenty-four (24) hours in advance of the following:
 - i. Excavation and removal of existing curb and sidewalk.
 - ii. Setting of forms
 - iii. Placement of concrete.







NOTES:

- (1) CONCRETE CURB TO BE 4,500 PSI NJDOT CLASS "B" (AIR ENTRAINED)
- (2) TRANSVERSE JOINTS 1/2" WIDE SHALL BE INSTALLED IN THE CURB 20'-0" APART AND SHALL BE FILLED WITH PREFORMED, BITUMINOUS-IMPREGNATED JOINT FILLER, COMPLYING WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF AASHTO M-213, RECESSED 1/4" FROM THE FRONT FACE AND TOP OF THE CURB.
- (3) DUMMY JOINTS (FORMED) SHALL BE INSTALLED MIDWAY BETWEEN EXPANSION JOINTS.
